# The Police and City's Approach

- Police have secured a grant which will allow for increased patrol resources along International Blvd.
- Police and Council have worked together on new codes aimed at steering homeless into resources
- City has passed a moratorium on shelters in SeaTac
  
- Notable issue – Shelter has been moved to the Sleep Inn
  - Changed dynamics
  - Things look different

- Notable increase in calls 2019 AND 2020 in the southern part of the area
    - The Reserve
    - Light Rail Termination
  - Additional trespass, welfare and mental health calls are consistent
  - It is clear that the addition of the shelter has created an increase in calls for service and activity along International Blvd.
  - Difficult to pinpoint direct, on premises increases in Hotel/Motel activity
    - No reason to expect the slight increases have not impacted those businesses
  - Side Effects – Perception

- Data not tracked prior to 2020
  - Some significant fluctuations in Trespassing in late spring and late summer
  - Notable jump in vehicle theft in the fall
  - Total events increased in late summer into fall, but correspond with increase in Area Checks
    - Notable is the high area checks and lower total calls prior to COVID
  - Data presents a slight upward trend for the year in most categories, consistent with activity citywide
